Notes:

1. BC Housing only tracks units where we have a financial relationship. There may be other subsidized housing units in the community.
2. BC Housing's 'Housing Continuum' reports are based on 'units' (housing units, beds, spaces and rent supplements, depending on each program) and do not report on the number of 'people' assisted.
3. Service Allocation definitions:
 - a. Homeless Housed: Housing for clients who are at the risk of homelessness, or formerly homeless for a period of at least 30 days and up to two or three years. This type of housing includes the provision of on- or off-site support services to help the clients move towards independence and self-sufficiency.
4. One four unit supportive housing project on Salt Spring Island has been excluded from these results.
5. Neighbourhood locations have been assigned based on inputting addresses into the City of Victoria and District of Saanich online GIS mapping tools.
6. Column D is calculated based on the % of Units within the community
7. Column E is calculated based on the % of Units within the CRD (Cell C18)
